COVID-19 UPDATE

As you will have seen in media reports, there has been a community acquired case of COVID-19 in a young man who has visited a range of locations across Brisbane and Moreton Bay areas. The Chief Health Officer has reintroduced the direction regarding visits to aged care services for Brisbane and Moreton Local Government Areas, effective at midday today.

As we have always done throughout this pandemic, we have followed the instructions of the Chief Health Officer as closely as we can, being mindful of the needs of our residents, their families and our staff.

As a result, effective immediately, all staff, visitors and contractors visiting Seasons communities at **Bribie Island, Kallangur, Mango Hill and Sinnamon Park** must wear masks at all times while they are onsite.

We are not restricting visitors completely at the moment, but ask that visitors limit their attendance at Seasons to essential visits only and that only 2 people at a time visit residents. Visits muct be conducted in the resident's apartment and until these restrictions are eased, having visitors attend for lunch in the dining room will suspended.

We also ask everyone onsite to maintain social distancing and be vigilant with their hand hygiene.
